Clown Incidents

We have been asked to pass on information about Clown Incidents from Essex Police.

Essex Police are aware of a $number\ of\ reports\ from$ concerned residents across the county relating to persons dressed as clowns specifically near to schools during opening times. It would appear the intentions of these 'clowns' is to scare members of the public however to date there have been no reports of physical threats of harm or violence being caused. These incidents follow on from a 'craze' originating in the ${\sf USA} \ {\sf whereby} \ {\sf persons}$ dressed as clowns have been photographed or filmed carrying outs various acts with the intention of scarina or causina fear. There has been huge public interest in these photographs and videos, particularly on social media networking sites which more often than not do not represent accurate reporting. This inaccurate reporting is further fuelling the 'craze' and creating a


