School Uniform Policy - From September 2014

The school firmly believes that the wearing of school uniform gives the children of our school a sense of identity, a sense of belonging and a sense of the importance we place in the community of St John's Green Primary School.

We believe that the policy outlined below is vital in enabling the school to embrace a communal sense of belonging.

Therefore, the School Uniform requirements for the children of our school are as follows:

Boys.

- Grey or black trousers.
- Grey or black shorts (these must not be sports shorts).
- White collared shirt or white polo shirt. (White polo shirts with the school logo are available from the school uniform suppliers*).
- Navy fleece, sweatshirt or jumper. (*Fleeces and sweatshirts with the school logo are available from the school uniform suppliers).
- Black shoes or black trainers.
- Navy, brown or black close-toed sandals.

Girls.

- Grey or black trousers or skirt.
- Grey or black shorts. (These must not be sports/cycling shorts)
- White collared shirt or white polo shirt. (*White polo shirts with the school logo are available from the school uniform suppliers).
- Navy fleece, sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. (*Fleeces and sweatshirts with the school logo are available from the school uniform suppliers).
- Blue checked summer dress.
- Grey pinafore.
- Sensible flat black shoes or black trainers.
- Navy, brown or black closed-toed sandals.

Coats.

Children are expected to have a sensible <u>waterproof</u> winter coat - (not a fleece), we walk between the school sites during the week.

Boys/Girls.

Hair.

Long hair must be tied back with a hair tie, must be a natural colour and should not be excessively spiked.

Jewellery.

Only a watch and stud earrings may be worn. (NB: if your child must wear a necklace/bracelet because of faith or health reasons then please notify the Headteacher)

Make Up.

No facial make up should be worn.

P.E. Foundation.

- Plain white polo shirt.
- Navy blue or black shorts. (A small motif is permissible)
- Plimsolls/pumps (No trainers)

P.E. KS1 and KS2

- Coloured Polo shirt, only available from the school uniform suppliers*, linked to the Team that children are allocated to.
- Navy blue or black shorts. (A small motif is permissible)
- Children must have trainers for P.E. and these must be a change of trainers should your child wear black trainers for school.
- Dance/Gymnastics will be undertaken in bare feet.
- A plain navy/black/grey track suit may be worn in the Autumn/Spring terms.

P.E. kit must be in school from Monday to Friday. The teaching of P.E. is a curriculum requirement and it is not acceptable for children not to have their kit in school.

Swimming.

Girls - One piece costume and swimming cap.

Boys - short shorts or trunks. Any boy with long hair will also be expected to wear a cap.

P.E. bags are available from the school office.

Everything must be named with either tags or permanent markers. Please check regularly to ensure that your child's name has not washed out.

Please Note: Failure to comply with the school uniform policy may result in disciplinary action being taken against the child.
