

#### Confirmed Case of Coronavirus

We have had a confirmed case of Coronavirus at the school in one of our classes. Alongside of this newsletter, parents will also have received a letter that details the fact we have a confirmed case within the school. I apologise that the letter is quite formal but it's an official template which is provided to us from County.

Because of the way we have set up the Bubbles, with separate areas in the lunch hall/playgrounds and classes not mixing in the school, only one class needs to Self Isolate.

I fully appreciate that for some parents the fact that we have a confirmed case within our direct community will cause huge anxiety. I would though, urge parents not to overthink this. Remember, the advice and guidance that the school and government has sent out about hygiene and social distancing. Symptoms in children are also normally very mild.

For all other children in the school, we will carry on as normal next week. Siblings of the children in the class that's had to isolate should continue to come to school as normal on Monday. It's only the child in the isolated class that has to isolate. I must stress though, that the children who are isolating MUST NOT come onto the school site—for any reason until their isolation period ends.

If needs be, we will support the parents of the class that are isolating in bringing children into school from the front of the school, but please let us know.

#### AP1 Reports to Parents and Parents Consultations

Your children's Assessment Period 1 (AP1—Autumn Term) reports will be coming out to you on Tuesday 8th December. In the absence of being able to nave parents in school to look at your children's work—class teachers will also include in the report a few bits of your children's work as chosen by your children.

Telephone consultations will take place during the day in the final week of term and more information on these will be sent out with your children's re-ports and popped on the school website. Your children will also be penning a letter to you about some of the things they've been learning in school.

#### All Things Christmas

Christmas Cards—We are allowing children to send Christmas Cards to each other via our normal 'Elf' postage system should you so wish, in much the same way as our post still arrives at home. Cards should have the recipients first name and surname as well as the class of the child. Class



Teachers will arrange a suitable time for posting of cards if your child wishes to send cards to a child outside of their class—but if sending cards to children in their own class these can be given directly to the class teacher.

Christmas Lunch-You will have noticed from both the school calendar and the dinner menu that our Christmas Lunch is fast approaching. EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2—it's on Tuesday 8th December. Year 3, 4, 5, 6—it's on Thursday 10th December. Please remember that all parents need to let us know if you want your child to have a Christmas Lunch and cracker, children in KS2 also need to let us know and also pay for the meal, unless your child is in receipt of FSM.

Christmas Dress up Day—Friday 18th December will be our Christmas dress up, non-uniform day—when children for a minimum £1 donation may come to school dressed as Christmassy as they like. Each year group will be choosing a different local charity to support, so parents can donate more than a £1 if they so like.

Christmas Crafts - Parents will be delighted to hear that classes will still be making their Christmas Crafts this year to entice you to spend a little bit of money on a one of a kind Christmas Tree Decoration, or a novelty ornament. These will all be highly desirable gifts, that no home should be without. All of the proceeds of this will go to the PTA and more details will be sent out in the final week of term—but keep some pound coins spare as I know you know you have to have these items!

- 1. Can I pay by cheque?
- Yes, please make cheques payable to St John's Green PTA
- 2. What size are the socks?
- The socks are all adult size 6-11
- 3. Who do I give the order form to?
- Please put the completed order form/catalogue and correct money (or cheque) into a sealed envelope and drop it into the letterbox at either school office.
- 4. When do orders need to be in by?
- All orders must be received by Monday 7th December at the latest.
- 5. Will Elfridges run out of stock?
- The PTA elves have ordered plenty of each item based on stock sold last year. However, Elfridges is proving to be quite popular, so we would ask you to get your orders in as early as possible. This will allow the elves to order additional stock in plenty of time and avoid disappointment.
