PF starts next week for all classes in the school PF is obviously a part of the National Curriculum and therefore, it is a statutory requirement for all children that they partake.

PE Kit

For children in Year 1—Year 6

Coloured Polo shirt (available from the school uniform suppliers), linked to the Team that children are allocated to

Navy blue or black shorts. (A small motif is permissible)

Children must have trainers for P.E. and these must be a change of trainers should your child wear black trainers for school.
