#### Jigsaw PHSE

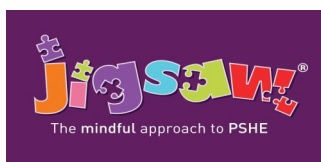
Our theme, this half term, is '**Changing Me**'. During these lessons, the children will be covering the following themes:
