Please find enclosed your child's report for the end of the first assessment period (6/9/17 - present). Please remember that this report is for you as parents.

We have tried very hard to ensure that the information it contains is both relevant and pertinent to keeping you informed as to how your child has progressed this academic year.

The expectations for children in each year group are in the table below. If your child is not at 'B' or 'B+' then there are gaps in some areas of their understanding and the application of that learning in their work and this means that they will need additional support to ensure they close the gaps in their learning. It is important that we work very closely with you as parents, so that you can support your children at home to help them make accelerated progress and to close those gaps.

Please carry on supporting your child in their learning each day over the Christmas break to ensure your child continues with the progress they've made.

Please however, do remember that learning is a journey and children do and will progress at different speeds. The two obvious questions to ask yourself are:

- Is your child happy at school?
- Are they progressing at the right speed in their learning?

If the answer to either question is no, then please speak to your child's classteacher, Mrs Bourne, Mrs Bullivant, Mrs Skinner or myself.

Please don't forget Open Evening this Wednesday 6th December from 5.00p.m. – 7.30p.m. at both sites. Please do come along to enjoy your children's work and talk to the class teachers about how your children are progressing.
