One Way System and Face Masks

Please remember that even though schools are open, we are still in a National Lockdown. Therefore the expectations we had in place with regards to Face masks/Social Distancing and the one way system in the Autumn Term, remain in place.

When on the school site, parents MUST wear face coverings and maintain social distancing.

The one way system remains in place.

At AF

(Year 1/Year 5/6) enter the site via the side gate in the passageway between Abbey Fields and Mersea Road and leave the site via the gate onto Abbey Fields.

EYFS—entering the learning garden via the small gate by the main entrance of the school and leaving through the double gates into the passage way and onto Abbey Fields.

At T

(Year 2/3/4) enter the site via the main entrance at the front of the school and leaving via either the car park or the gate onto Flagstaff Road.

Into School on Monday 8th March

We will be using Hand Gel only at the doors from Monday 8th with children coming straight into school and into their class bases. This will reduce the queuing by the washbasins, which will still be utilised during the day.

Children may still use the washbasins but this must be supervised by their parents.
