I'm afraid that the news about the AF kitchen is not good, though it will be resolved as quickly as possi-

As previously stated, the water from the leak came directly onto the central unit in the AF kitchen and mixed with the fat, which then spread across the kitchen floor and into the hall. Unfortunately, this also ingressed under the floor and has soaked into the scree. The only way forward is for the floor to be removed and a further period of drying to take place before they can start the remedial works. This was confirmed over the Half Term.

Obviously this is not ideal and the school's hands are very much tied because this is in the hands of the insurers

We are also very aware that the current provision we have in place for school dinners is not ideal or satisfactory as far as the children is concerned.

We are looking, with Essex CC, at a number of solutions and these include:

- The provision of a mobile catering unit at the AF
- The provision of a container so that the school equipment can be taken out of the AF hall and stored
- What hot options the school can provide utilising it's current kitchen at T and it's capacity and the feasibility of transporting them to maintain food standards.

The school is, in this situation, beholden to the insurers and Essex CC and we are working with them to expediate the solution as quickly as possible. I know this is not helpful as far as hot meals at AF is concerned but please be assured we are doing what we can as fast as we can, whilst waiting for the decisions to be made.




Spanish Day
