Year 3 Synagogue Trip

Upon entering the Synagogue, we learned about the 'Star of David' and the meaning behind this important Jewish symbol. The boys wore a kippah to cover their heads (girls could too if they wanted). The children learned about the special 'mezuzah' which is a box or holder in the door way of a home or synagogue which holds a special prayer.

We looked at the Torah scrolls and the special cabinet they are kept in. Lee showed us on a smaller scroll how they are unrolled and read each week. It takes a whole year to read through all of the Torah and if you unrolled the big scroll, it would reach the length of a football pitch!

Towards the end of our visit, we talked about Shabbat and the Sabbath day and we got to try some lovely sweet bread!
