

Swimming for Year 5/6

Just a reminder to Year 5/6 children that your swimming starts very soon.

Specific details will be coming out in a letter which we will also e-mail to parents.

Please remember that: Girls need a one-piece swimming costume and boys need swimming trunks (boys must wear swimming trunks and not swimming shorts.) Swimming shorts increase the amount of drag in the water and are not as hygienic as swimming trunks.

Children should not wear swimwear to school under their uniform as there are changing facilities at the pools. Swimwear should be with their towel in their bag and all children should change at the pool. It is not hygienic for children to be wearing their swimwear, walking to the pools, going to the toilet during the morning and then swimming in it.

Please also remember that girls and any boy with long hair must wear a swimming hat.


