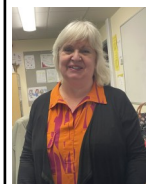
The second half of the Autumn Term starts on Tuesday 4th November.

Full Governing Body 15/10/25

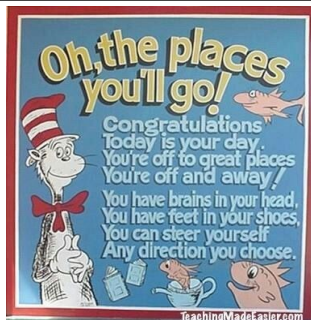
The Governing Body met for our regular meeting on the 15/10/25 where we did our annual safeguarding training. One of the things that we discussed are the threats that children often face unnecessarily early in their lives through unmonitored access to mobile phones.
