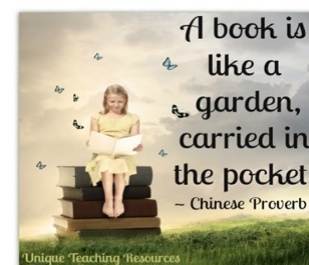
Year 4
