Dear Parents.

Please find enclosed your child's report for the end of the second assessment period (January – March 2019). Please remember that this report is for you as parents.

We have tried very hard to ensure that the information it contains is both relevant and pertinent to keeping you informed as to how your child has progressed so far this academic year.

The expectations for children in each year group are in the table below. If your child is not at 'W' or 'W+' then there are gaps in some areas of their understanding and the application of that learning in their work and this means that they will need additional support to ensure they close the gaps in their learning. It is important that we work very closely with you as parents, so that you can support your children at home to help them make accelerated progress and to close those gaps.

Within your child's reports are listed both the ways we are supporting your child's learning but also how you can support their learning at home.

Please however, do remember that learning is a journey and children do and will progress at different speeds. The two obvious questions to ask yourself are:

- Is your child happy at school?
- Are they progressing at the right speed in their learning?

If the answer to either question is no, then please speak to your child's class teacher, Mrs Bourne, Mrs Bullivant, Mrs Skinner or myself.

On the school website under 'Reports' is an information document that breaks down the different sections of the report.
